In 1938, *Mooramong* homestead was revamped in "Hollywood style" by wealthy Australian grazier Donald "Scobie" Mackinnon for his American movie star wife Claire Adams.

Mooramong recaptures the glamorous life and times of the Mackinnons from the 1930s to the 1960s. Their wonderful house features photographs, curios and objects d'art.
