

### AT CAMPERDOWN.

His Excellency the Governor and suite (says the *Western Press* of Saturday) arrived at Camperdown on Thursday last, at 4 p.m., *en route* to Glenormiston, where the illustrious party will make a few days' sojourn at the residence of the Hon. Neil Black. We understand that it is the intention of His Excellency to visit as many of the townships in the Western District as time will permit, but it is his expressed wish that the tour westward shall be an unofficial one. His Excellency was loudly cheered on his arrival at Wiggins's Leura Hotel, where he was received by Shire Councillors Curdie, McArthur and Shaw; and to make the picture under the verandah as interesting as possible, the aboriginal chief, King Billy, with Dick Manifold, were presented to the Governor, and appeared highly delighted with the honour conferred upon them. After half an hour's rest the carriage and pair of bays were brought to the door, and the vice regal tourists took their departure, but not without another cheer being given for His Excellency, and a hearty one for Lady Manners Sutton. An address from the Shire Council had been prepared for presentation, but as his Excellency preferred reading it at Glenormiston, it has been forwarded thither.—*Warrnambool Examiner*, 13th inst.
