"To this spot Queen Fanny, 'Bareetch Chuurneen', was pursued by the white men, who murdered nearly all her tribe at Puuroyuup, on the banks of Taylor's River, and pursued the remnants of them to Bullen Merri" (Dawson); Dawson 1881: lxxxiii; Blake Papers 2000.

Curdies River; *Ngarrawurru*; hair lip; Giraiwurrung; [Corangamite; 7521 54 750459; Giraiwurrung]; Also known as Curdie Vale, Nirranda, Boggy Creek; Lane in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 186; Blake Papers 2000.

Currie's Swamp; *Burntah*; long thatch grass; Djargurdwurrung; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Currie's Swamp on Mr Ware's run 'Koort Koort Nong', near Camperdown; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 185.

Currie's Swamp; *Giranghabum*; native root like onions; Djargurdwurrung; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Large Swamp, Mr Currie's - Mr Ware's run, 'Koort Koort Nong', N of Camperdown; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 185.

Derrinallum; *Djerinallum*; home of sea swallows or terns; Marr or Wadawurrung; [Corangamite; 7522 54 950975; Djargurdwurrung]; corruption of Djerinallum: Djargurdwurrung or Wadawurrung place name for Mt Elephant. In 1839 name of pastoral run held by Lang and Elms. When surveyed in 1860s, settlement name Tooliorook - see Elephant, Mount. Local clan known as Djerinallum gundidj; Dawson 1881: lxxxix.

Elephant Marsh; *Wooriobolook*; buluk = lake; Wathawurrung; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Elephant Marsh, in Parish of Tooliorook, Co of Hampden; SE of Mt Elephant; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 184.

Elingamite, Lake; Yelingamadj keelingk; keelingk = lake; Giraiwurrung; [Corangamite; 7521 54 755530; Giraiwurrung]; Ewen McDonnell n stn W of Camperdown 1845; local Giraiwurrung clan Yelingamadj gundidj (Clark 1990a: 209); Robinson jnl, 9/4/1841; Clark 2000g: 66.

Ewen Hill (Gnarogein, Mount); Narrokeeing; [Corangamite; 7521 54 766626; Djargurdwurrung]; previously known as Mount Gnarogein; According to Robinson (jnl 16/4/1841) hill in which Toolook worite takes its rise (Robinson); McAlpine 1982:56; Blake 1977: 199.

Foxhow; Mita; Djargurdwurrung; [Corangamite; 7521 54 160860; Djargurdwurrung]; n derives from Westmoreland, England; SG in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 179.

Frenchmans Swamp; Tocoureeit; [Corangamite; 7521 54 760690; Djargurdwurrung]; marsh nr Boorcan in Parish of Marida Yallock; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 184.

Geelenga; Keelingk; lake; Marr; [Corangamite; 7521 54 942902; Djargurdwurrung]; in 1844, squatter, Jason Kinross n pastoral run SW of Lismore Geelengla (or Gelengla). The n was later changed to Larra; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 181.

Geritger; Geritger; Marr; [Corangamite; 7521 54 980628; Djargurdwurrung]; spring and small creek NE of Lake Purrumbete; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 181.

Gheringal; Kirrngkarl; dog urine; Marr; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; lake or marsh nr Derrinallum; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 182.

Giringcall; Kirrngkarl; dog urine; Marr; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; in Parish of Colongulac; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 182.

Glenormiston - environs; Ngara burn burn; name of plant growing there; Giraiwurrung; [Corangamite; 7421 54 710735; Giraiwurrung]; When Niel Black and Co arrived at this pastoral run and took over from McKillop and Smith, the n was changed from Strathdownie. One of Black's partners was from Glenormiston, Scotland; Dawson 1881: lxxix.

Gnarpurt, Lake; Kongiadigallock; yaluk = creek/river; Wathawurrung; [Corangamite; 7521 54 100850; Djargurdwurrung]; previously known as Little Corangamite; Buckley in Morgan 1967: 36.

Gnarpurt, Lake; Ngarpurt; Marr; [Corangamite; 7521 54 100850; Djargurdwurrung]; once called Kinloch Abbett or Little Corangamite NW of L Corangamite; Porteous in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 179.

Green Hill - Koort Koort Nong; Murton; Djargurdwurrung; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; The Green Hill, on Mr Ware's Run, 'Koort Koort Nong', N of Camperdown; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 185.

Jancourt; Djargurd; Djargurdwurrung; [Corangamite; 7521 54 830510; Djargurdwurrung]; pastoral stn n, rural district nr Cobden; Clark 1990a: 177, 179.

Jancourt Homestead; Currycong; [Corangamite; 7521 54 830510; Djargurdwurrung]; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 181.

Jancourt - Homestead; Kulorr; lava stone; Marr; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Small hill on which Hugh Scott's 'Jancourt' Homestead is built; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 182.

Karm Karm; Karm Karm; building of stones; Marr; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; point of land below Wuuromg House, where Aboriginal people formed their wuurni of stones (Dawson 1881); see entry for Peak of Almond.

"Wurrong' was a farm nr Camperdown that was the residence of James Dawson; Dawson 1881: 11, lxxx.

Keayang Home Station; Karngeeyang; karnk = hill, mountain; Marr; [Corangamite; Giraiwurrung]; Keayang or Richardson's station, on the left bank of Mt Emu Ck, S of Terang; comes from Karnghiegung gundidj, Giraiwurrung clan SW of Lake Terang (see Clark 1990a: 212); Lane in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 187; Hercus 1999; Blake 2000.

Keilambete, Lake; Kilambidj killingk; brackish water lake; Marr; [Corangamite; 7421 54 645695; Giraiwurrung]; local clan known as Kilambidj gundidj; Lane in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 187.

Kerbyleet; Kerbyleet; Marr; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Marsh E of Camperdown, transecting the parishes of North Purrumbete and Colongulac; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 182.

Kilnoorat Cemetery; Wirrayt-wirrayt; banksia tree; Marr; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Cemetery in Parish of Kilnoorat, Co of Hampdon; nr Mt Meningerot; see Kilnoorat Road - RD4&5 514 770820; Dawson 1881: lxxxiii.

Kilnoorat cemetery - bank; Tuulirn; red earth; Marr; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Kilnoorat cemetery bank, presumably on Mount Emu Creek; Dawson 1881: lxxxii; Blake Papers 2000.

Kilnoorat Church - site; Wurringii; noise; Marr; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Kilnoorat church site at Darlington on the Mount Emu Creek; Dawson 1881: lxxxiii.

Koang, Mount; Kooyang; eel; Djargurdwurrung; [Corangamite; 7521 54 851831; Djargurdwurrung]; RPNV 1983; Krishna-Pillay 1996: 163.

Kohiear; Kohiear; [Corangamite; Djargurdwurrung]; Marsh nr Tandarook, in the Parish of Tandarook; Scott in Smyth 1878 Vol. 2: 182.

Koinjerer; Koinjerer; Giraiwurrung; [Corangamite; 7421 54 686620; Giraiwurrung]; small rivulet that runs into Black's Ri [Mt Emu Ck] SE from Killambeet [Keilambete, Lake q.v.), Worowerer (Robinson) (see Mount Emu Creek); Robinson jnl, 16/4/1841.
